Dream Team Honor Code

When you become a leader at Celebration Church, you're committing to live your life at a higher standard. Everyone grows! As a leader, it's especially important that you pursue learning and growth throughout your lifetime and demonstrate mature behavior as a follower of Christ. The Bible is our foundation for what it means to be mature in our thoughts, words, and actions. When you assume responsibility for leading others, and take on the title of leader, you must remember that your behavior and reputation represent Celebration Church and the body of Christ. For this reason, it's important that all leaders are aligned with our church beliefs and core values. For clarity, some specific examples are listed below.

STANDARDS

We ask that you:

- Strive to demonstrate Biblical standards in speech and attitude in all situations
- Maintain a daily time of prayer
- Read your Bible and apply His Word to your actions
- Present a clean appearance

BEHAVIORS

We expect that you refrain from:

- Profanity
- Overindulgence of alcoholic beverages
- Dishonest activity
- Illegal drugs
- Pornography
- Sexual immorality
- Illegal activities (behavior that is contrary to governmental laws)
- Any and all behaviors that do not line up with the Word of God

ENVIRONMENTS

We uphold our responsibility to honor Christ and Church by:

- Maintaining alcohol-free environments for small group or team gatherings and meetings. This means not meeting in venues that are specifically intended for alcohol consumption (bars) or allowing alcohol to be brought into the environment (such as a tasting or meal with alcohol provided by the host, leader, or guests).
- Maintain tobacco-free environments for small group gatherings or team gatherings.
- Creating positive social media environments by being mindful and aware of our effects of what we post on social media. As a leader, your posts represent not only yourself, but His church as well. Seek to be a positive voice and reflection of Christ through your social media platforms.

I realize that by accepting this Leadership Commitment, I am not adopting a list of "don'ts" that are restrictive or legalistic. Instead, agreeing to uphold this Leadership Commitment shows that God has freed me to live in ways that reflect the life-change that only He can bring. I am a new creation who gives evidence that God accepts me where I am, but loves us so much He won't let me stay there!

How we do what we do

WEEKEND SERVICES

Our worship gatherings as a church.

We meet at many locations to experience Christ together, learn His word, and connect with others.

BAPTISMS

Water baptism is our next step if we have made a decision to commit our life to Christ. Baptism is an outward declaration of inner change, and symbolic of leaving our old life behind and being raised to new life in Christ.

CELEBRATION KIDS

Celebration Kids is the children's ministry at Celebration Church. We partner with parents to help kids build their own spiritual foundation by learning about Jesus and the Bible through fun, age-appropriate worship, and activities so they can understand the simple truth that Jesus loves them. We offer something for every child, age six weeks – 5th grade.

CELEBRATION STUDENTS

Celebration Students is the student ministry at Celebration Church for middle school, high school, and college-aged students. Celebration Students exist to see students passionately love Jesus and empowered to make a difference through the local church through authentic community with authentic mission. We have weekly gatherings, WAVE Nights, Small Groups, and outreach serve opportunities.

CONFERENCES

Conferences at Celebration Church are where we set aside time, away from our everyday routine, to gather together around the name of Jesus. We do this through our yearly women's conference, Radiant, our yearly student conference, WAVE Student Conference, and our biannual Freedom Conferences.

CELEBRATION MUSIC

Established by Pastors Joe and Lori Champion and Celebration Church in the year 2000, this collective of worship leaders seek to shine a light of Hope in a city searching for purpose.

KIDS CAMP

Celebration Kids camp is a time for your kids to encounter Jesus in a whole new way. They will experience live worship, fun games, and exciting teachings on the Word of God, all while forming meaningful friendships.

CONNECTION POINT

Connection Point is the first step to getting connected with Celebration Church. This two-step process is designed to help others grow in their relationship with Christ and connect to the church. During Step 1, we learn about who we are as a church, our history, our beliefs, and the important of "Christ First." During Step 2, we learn about the heart of Celebration Church that is the foundation for all our ministries.


Leadership Structure

Hubs


As small groups grow at each location, we hope to establish "Hubs." Hubs are communities of groups that serve a particular demographic. Once a location has 12 groups within a specific demographic, we hope to see a HUB LEADER assigned; eventrually establishing 5 Hubs at each location:



Coaches

Once a Hub and a Hub Leader have been established (with a min of 12 groups), the next level of leadership are our "coaches." Each coach is meant to invest in the small group leaders of no more than 12 groups.

ADULTS

Our worship gatherings as a An Adults Small Group Hub is a dynamic gathering of individuals, primarily in co-ed groups, designed to foster connection, growth, and community. These groups meet off-site in homes, coffee shops, or other welcoming spaces, providing a relaxed environment for building relationships and deepening faith. Each group engages with a variety of curriculums tailored to their interests and spiritual journeys, including Bible studies, topical discussions, and practical guides for everyday life. By offering flexibility in meeting locations and content, these hubs create opportunities for meaningful conversations and shared experiences that encourage both personal and spiritual development.

YOUNG ADULTS / COLLEGE

The Young Adults Hub is a dynamic community designed for individuals ages 18-30, providing a space to grow in faith, build meaningful relationships, and navigate life's challenges together. Within the hub, there are both young men's groups and young women's groups, allowing for focused connection and encouragement. These groups meet exclusively off-site in diverse locations such as homes, coffee shops, or other casual venues, creating a relaxed atmosphere for authentic conversations. Each group engages with a variety of curriculums, from Bible studies to discussions on topics relevant to young adulthood. The Young Adults Hub offers a supportive and empowering environment for young people to thrive spiritually and relationally during this formative stage of life.

WOMEN

(RADIANT SISTERS)

Radiant Sisters is a vibrant community of women committed to growing in faith, building authentic relationships, and encouraging one another in every season of life. These all-women groups provide a welcoming space to connect and be inspired. Offsite groups meet in various locations such as homes, cafes, or parks, offering flexibility and variety in both setting and curriculum, which ranges from Bible studies to topical discussions that address real-life challenges. On-site groups meet at the church campus and operate on a semester schedule, providing structured opportunities to engage with other women in a shared journey of faith. Radiant Sisters empowers women to flourish spiritually, emotionally, and relationally, while creating lifelong bonds of sisterhood.

MEN

(CELEBRATION MEN)

Celebration Men is a vibrant ministry dedicated to fostering growth, accountability, and brotherhood among men of all ages. Comprised exclusively of men, the groups provide a supportive environment to deepen faith and build lasting relationships.

Off-site groups meet in various locations such as homes, coffee shops, or workplaces and engage with a range of curriculums tailored to spiritual growth and practical life application. On-site groups gather at the church campus and operate on a semester basis, offering structured sessions that align with the church's seasonal programming. Together, Celebration Men empowers men to lead with integrity, grow in their walk with Christ, and strengthen their roles within their families, workplaces, and communities.

STUDENTS

The STUDENTS Hub is a thriving ministry designed to connect Middle School and High School students with peers and leaders as they grow in their relationship with Jesus. Middle School students meet on-site every Sunday, engaging in age-appropriate teachings and activities that encourage spiritual growth and community. High School students gather throughout the week for small groups, fostering deeper connections in a more personal and relaxed environment. Both groups explore various curriculums tailored to their unique life stages, from Bible studies to discussions on relevant topics. The STUDENTS Hub creates a safe and encouraging space where young people can discover their identity in Christ, build lasting friendships, and be equipped for a life of purpose.

Groups

OFF-SITE GROUPS

Off-site groups offer a flexible and diverse approach to building community, meeting people where they are in both location and interest. These free-market groups are tailored to the passions and needs of their members, with some being activity-based—such as fitness, hiking, or crafting—while others are curriculum-based, focusing on Bible studies or topical discussions. They gather in various locations, including homes, parks, coffee shops, or other welcoming spaces, providing a casual and accessible environment for connection. Unlike semester-based groups, off-site groups meet year-round but often take breaks during the summer and holidays, allowing members to enjoy a rhythm that fits their lifestyles while fostering consistent relationships and spiritual growth.

ON-SITE GROUPS

On-site groups provide a structured and focused opportunity for spiritual growth and connection, meeting at the church location for convenience and consistency. These groups are curriculum-based, offering studies that dive deep into Biblical principles, personal growth, and practical application. On-site groups operate on an 8-week schedule, running during the spring, summer, and fall semesters, making it easy for participants to engage in a defined time frame. With a supportive environment and centralized location, on-site groups are an excellent way to grow in faith and build relationships within the church community.

FREEDOM

Freedom Groups are designed to help individuals break free from barriers that hinder their intimacy with Christ, addressing topics such as unforgiveness, pride, and fear while equipping participants to live in the fullness of God's promises. These groups follow an 8-week curriculum and are available both on-site at the church and off-site in homes or other welcoming spaces, providing flexibility for attendees. Participants engage with a comprehensive workbook, which can be purchased, to guide them through the transformational journey. Freedom Groups culminate in the powerful Freedom Conference held in the fall, where participants experience a deeper level of healing, restoration, and empowerment in their walk with Christ.

Classes

SYMBIS

SYMBIS classes, short for Saving Your Marriage Before It Starts, are designed to help engaged couples build a strong foundation for their marriage. This class guides couples through a 12-week curriculum that addresses essential topics like communication, conflict resolution, and understanding each other's personalities. As part of the experience, each couple takes an individual assessment that provides personalized insights to foster deeper understanding and growth in their relationship. SYMBIS is primarily held on-site at the church and creates a supportive environment where couples can learn together, share experiences, and prepare for a lifetime of love and commitment rooted in God's principles.


FINANCIAL PEACE UNIVERSITY

Financial Peace University (FPU) classes empower individuals and families to gain control of their finances and experience freedom through Biblical principles of financial stewardship. These groups cover essential topics such as budgeting, saving, debt elimination, and building wealth, offering practical tools and strategies for financial success. FPU follows a 12-week curriculum, providing participants with a step-by-step framework for transforming their financial habits. Groups meet both onsite at the church and off-site in homes or community spaces, offering flexibility and convenience. CARE

Care Classes provide a supportive environment for individuals navigating challenging seasons of life, offering hope, healing, and practical guidance. Care Classes cater to specific needs, including support for those who have suffered loss, guidance for individuals going through a divorce, and recovery-focused programs for those overcoming addiction. Each class is designed to foster connection, provide tools for personal growth, and encourage participants to experience God's love and restoration in their journey.
