

"For Your Kids — Give to Your Family" Small Group Discussion Guide

Key Scriptures: Matthew 6:26-30; Proverbs 6:6-8, 13:22; 1 Timothy 5:8

Key Points: God is <u>generous</u> with us so that we can be <u>generous</u> with our families. He also acknowledges that <u>providing</u> is hard. The Bible calls God <u>provider</u>. Do you?

Group Opener:

What was your first memory of being worried about money, and how does that shape your view of finances today?

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Why do you think money is such a difficult or touchy subject in the church? In your relationships?
- 2. Read Matthew 6:26-30. Jesus highlights that God provides for sparrows and flowers. How does that image help your ability to trust Him to carry the weight of your finances?
- 3. How does the desire to have more than enough hinder our ability to see when we do have more than enough?
- 4. What does it mean that God is good, and how can this truth reshape your relationship with money and provision?
- 5. How might God be inviting you to trust Him to provide? Take a few minutes to pray about this.
