Scripture: Romans 10:8-17

Sermon Points:

God invites us to know Him and make Him known

 God invites us into the power of the good news (v9-13) The good news is personal (v9)

The good news is confessional (v10-11)

The good news is unconditional (v12-13)

2. God invites us into the passing on of the good news (v14-17)

Group Opener: Share the short story (2 min max) of who told you about Jesus and how you gave your life to Christ.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. God invites us to know Him and make Him known to others. Why do you think some people separate those two?
- 2. Read Romans 10:14-15, map out the flow of five verbs that show how God uses people to reach people.

God sends -> You speak -> Others hear -> They believe -> They call on -> Jesus Saves

- 3. Jesus' primary method of bringing people to Himself is our relationships. Why do you think God prioritizes outreach in our relationships?
- 4. Pull up your "Pray + Invite" card from your phone. Share what you're doing to reach those listed.
