MY APPLICATION

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

1. Solomon crowded God out of his heart. List a few things people allow to crowd their hearts. What might be crowding God out of your heart these days?
2. Ahab humbled himself to God's correction and found blessing. In what areas is God inviting you to humble yourself? What blessing do you long for?
3. Josiah broke the family cycle of sin through whole-hearted devotion to God. From 2 Kings 23:24-25, what did that involve? How does that speak to your life?
4. The arc of the story of the Kings leads us to cry out for God to be our True King. Is Jesus the Sovereign King of your heart? How are you yielding your desires to Him?
5. Set aside some time this week to prayerfully "clean and reorder the garage of your heart" before God.
