## Week 4 | Let My People Go | Exodus 5-10

1. Read Exodus 5-10
2. In Chapter 5, Moses and Aaron approached Pharaoh King of Egypt and used the famous line, "Let my people go." According to Exodus 5:1 and 3, what was the reason for the request?
3. Pharaoh not only denied their request, he made life even harder for the Hebrews. What did he do? Exodus 5:9-16
4. The Israelite foreman complained to Pharaoh and then complained to Moses and Aaron. Who did Moses complain to in Exodus 5:22-23 and was the situation immediately resolved?
5. How could you benefit from going to God first with any injustice in your life? Does this guarantee immediate relief?
6. In Exodus 6:1-8 God says he has "remembered his covenant with the Hebrews." List what God promises he will do in Exodus 6:6-8.
7. When Moses tries to share this great revelation with the Israelites they didn't listen. Why? Exodus 6:9
8. In chapter 7, things begin to heat up. Moses and Aaron once again face Pharaoh and this time the plagues begin. How old are Moses and Aaron? Exodus 7:7
9. On the next page, chart the miracle of the snake and the first 9 plagues. If there is no answer leave the box blank.
