Discussion Questions:

1. Hagar and her son Ishmael are again treated unfairly. They are foreigners, marginalized, and destitute. They are also made in the image of God, who sees and provides for them. How can we reflect the heart of God toward the disadvantaged in our world?
2. Life is full of highs, lows, and times of uncertainty. Think of a recent time you faced uncertainty. Did you expect God to give you a "good" outcome or did you trust he was good no matter the outcome? Why is it important to put our faith in God and not what he gives?
3. Abraham's actions prove he prioritized his love and obedience to God above all else, even over the love of his precious son Isaac. What in your life fights to be the #1 spot in your heart, even above God? (People, relationships, occupation, activities, dreams, goals, finances, comfort) What would loving God above all else look like in your life?
