

Scripture: Luke 15:1-32

Sermon Points:

- 1. We live in an age where depth of conviction is defined by a depth of anger.
- 2. Jesus will always be better.

Group Opener: Read Luke 15:1-2 Then discuss the context of the word "SINNER" from Jesus time in history to our time.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What do the Story of Lost Sheep & Lost Coin have in common?
- 2. Think about the perspective of hearing the story of the Prodigal Son for the very first time...
 - How would hearing the story unfold for the first time be different than those of us who have heard the story before and know how it ends?
- 3. There are differences between the story of Prodigal Son (v 11-31) compared to Story of Lost Sheep & Lost Coin.
 What do you think Jesus was trying to communicate to the Pharisees?
- 4. Our moment in time is unique and special. The older generations grew up in a culture with a majority of faith, those in the younger generations have a minority of faith.
 - How do you live in this reality and tell people that "Jesus will always be better"?
