



**Scripture:** Luke 15:1-32

**Sermon Points:**

1. We live in an age where depth of conviction is defined by a depth of anger.
2. Jesus will always be better.

**Group Opener:** Read Luke 15:1-2 Then discuss the context of the word "SINNER" from Jesus time in history to our time.

**Discussion Questions:**

1. What do the Story of Lost Sheep & Lost Coin have in common?
2. Think about the perspective of hearing the story of the Prodigal Son for the very first time...  
How would hearing the story unfold for the first time be different than those of us who have heard the story before and know how it ends?
3. There are differences between the story of Prodigal Son (v 11-31) compared to Story of Lost Sheep & Lost Coin.  
What do you think Jesus was trying to communicate to the Pharisees?
4. Our moment in time is unique and special. The older generations grew up in a culture with a majority of faith, those in the younger generations have a minority of faith.  
How do you live in this reality and tell people that "Jesus will always be better"?
