

Putting Your Talent to Use

Scripture: Matthew 25:14-30

Sermon Points:

Big Idea: Whatever God has entrusted to you, you must use it or lose it.

Talent: The unique set of resources God has entrusted to you

Every talent includes a responsibility from God. (Matthew 25:14-19) Every talent invites profitability for God. (Matthew 25:20-27) Every talent involves accountability to God. (Matthew 25:28-30)

NOTE: Small Group Leaders remind people that through the series we will discuss Time, Truth , Treasure, Talent & Tears. Through this series please pray and consider which topic you will focus on as an individual.

Group Opener:

Read Matthew 25:14-18, which person do you connect with the most and why?

Discussion Questions:

- 1. God will let you, (1) waste your life, or (2) spend your life on temporary things, or (3) invest your life in Him. Which one best describes your current reality?
- 2. Scripture teaches that God owns it all and loans us all we have. Discuss how that affects your use of money, time, relationships, and hardships?
- 3. When God gives you a talent, the devil attaches a fear to it to keep you from using it for God. Discuss the three fears Pastor Jim mentioned. Discuss how you are overcoming your fears.
- 4. Read Matthew 25:23

His master said to him, "Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master"

Discuss why faithfulness is critical to fulfilling God's purpose.
