Discussion Questions:

1. Joseph's early life is marked by tragic and unjust circumstances, yet we know God was still at work. How does this encourage you during difficult times?
2. Joseph's brothers were eaten up with envy and hate which caused horrible consequences. Read Galatians 5:16-26. As Christ followers, what fruit should be evident in our lives?
3. God is at work even through dysfunctional relationships. Have you experienced this truth in your own life? (Remember to answer respectfully.)
4. Following God does not promise us a pit-free life. However, we can trust God is with us and working out his plan even *in* the pits of life. Why is this truth important to believe before we find ourselves in the pit?
