

Joseph and His Brothers' Treachery Genesis 37 and 39

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Joseph's early life is marked by tragic and unjust circumstances, yet we know God was still at work. How does this encourage you during difficult times?
- 2. Joseph's brothers were eaten up with envy and hate which caused horrible consequences. Read Galatians 5:16-26. As Christ followers, what fruit should be evident in our lives?
- 3. God is at work even through dysfunctional relationships. Have you experienced this truth in your own life? (Remember to answer respectfully.)
- 4. Following God does not promise us a pit-free life. However, we can trust God is with us and working out his plan even *in* the pits of life. Why is this truth important to believe before we find ourselves in the pit?
