

Food Insecurity – August 25

Reveal Resource Center (member of Christian Resource Center) is a food, clothing, and diaper pantry located at Twin Lakes Fellowship.

- Help organize donations on Monday morning
- Drive to pick up donations during the week
- Help distribute food, clothes, and diapers Monday evenings or Tuesday mornings

Hill Country Community Ministries provides food, clothing, and other assistance to individuals in crisis and those living in poverty in the Greater Leander area.

- Serve at their food pantry by assembling client orders, organizing food donations and stocking shelves.
- Drive to pick up donations for food pantry and thrift store
- Serve at their thrift store by greeting and assisting shoppers as well as help sort clothing
- Help mow grass and maintain their property outside

The Charlie Center provides navigation services – ID, medical, nutrition, permanent housing, and mailing address services – for our neighbors experiencing homelessness.

- Serve food on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday mornings
- Cook food at home and deliver it to the center

Mobile Loaves & Fishes/Community First! Village (MLF/CFV): Mobile Loaves & Fishes (MLF) is renowned for its food truck ministry, serving those experiencing homelessness on the streets of Austin. Community First! Village (CFV) is an extension of this mission, offering a master-planned community that provides affordable, permanent, supportive housing for individuals transitioning out of chronic homelessness.

- **Mobile Loaves & Fishes Food Truck Ministry:**
 - Participate in a make-ready team to prepare sandwiches and other meal items for a truck run.
 - Participate in a truck run from the village to distribute food on the streets of Austin.
- **Community First! Village:**
 - Take a tour of CFV with your family or small group to learn more about our community.
 - Coordinate a serve day with your group or family, involving activities like gardening, landscaping, or other beautification projects.
 - Partner with a CFV neighborhood for monthly meals and fellowship.
 - Serve individually in areas such as the Living Room, Entrepreneur Hub, or at the Farmers or Community Market.

Mission Possible Food Pantry connects the body of Christ across Greater Austin with individuals in under-resourced areas of east Austin for personal transformation through life-on-life relationships.

- Deliver groceries to the elderly and shut-in population.

Bags of Grace is focused on serving the homeless in Austin by preparing bags of necessities at a monthly assembly event at Hill Country Bible Church.

- Join our monthly assembly events at the Hill Country Bible Church gym (Saturday prior to the 2nd Sunday of each month) and assemble bags that will be delivered to Church Under the Bridge, The Charlie Center, Austin Street Youth and Feed my People.
