3. Read Luke 4:28-30. Why do you think the people were so angry that they rejected Jesus to the point that they wanted to kill him?
4. Luke 4:23-27 teaches us that Jesus has come for those who will admit their spiritual need. In 2025 what needs have you brought to God in prayer?
5. How do you respond to Jesus' offer of spiritual freedom? What progress do you need to make in growing in that freedom?
