  - ➤ Adam's passivity (Genesis 3:1-6) VS.
  - ➤ Jesus rejects passivity (Phil 2:5-8)

- Accepts Responsibility
  - ➤ Adam disregarded his responsibility (Gen 3:11-12) VS.
  - > Jesus accepts his responsibility (John 4:34)
  - What is our responsibility?

    ₩We have a work to do
    ₩We have a woman to love
