



❖ Accepts Responsibility

➤ Adam disregarded his responsibility (Gen 3:11-12)

VS.

➤ Jesus accepts his responsibility (John 4:34)

❖ Expects the Greater Reward, God's Reward

- Adam sought the *great* reward of being *like* God
- Jesus sought the *greater* reward of being *with* God
 - ✚ Hebrews 12:2
 - What is our greater reward?

 - ✚ Malachi 3:10
 - ✚ Psalm 37:4
 - ✚ 1 Corinthians 2:9
