



Seeing With Eyes of Faith

Scripture: 2 Kings 6:8 - 7:20

Sermon Points:

Those who seek God will see God's presence and power everywhere.

1. God is present, protecting His people. (2 Kings 6:8-23)
2. God is present, providing for His people. (2 Kings 6:24-7:20)

Application:

- To see God, let go of your expectations.
- To see God, assume His presence and look for Him.

Group Opener

Remind the group of the "Clown riding a unicycle" illustration from the start of the message. Were the results of this experiment surprising to you? Why or why not?

This summer how have you seen God working in your life and your family?

Discussion Questions:

1. What does the word "omnipresence" mean when it applies to God? Have you ever doubted that God is with you?
2. Read 1 Kings 6:15-17
Elisha prayed to open the eyes of his servant to see the angel army around them. When you read a passage like this, do you believe that they were seeing God's army, or was it just a vision of something not real? Why does that matter?
3. The lepers who find the Aramean camp deserted feel compelled to take the good news back to the rest of the starving people. (See 2 Kings 7:9)
Do you feel compelled to share the good news of Jesus with others? How have you been practicing B.L.E.S.S. this summer?
4. Read Matthew 7:7-8
Remember, those who seek God will see God's presence and power everywhere. What are some practices that you use to help you "ask, see, and knock?"
