

## Your Treasure and Your Heart

Scripture: Matthew 6:19-34

## Sermon Points:

A Kingdom Request - It calls on you to invest somewhere else. It calls on you to change your heart.

A Kingdom Reason - You will hit what you aim at.

A King's Response - Investing in the kingdom grows a trust in the King. Consider what role giving has in your spiritual life. Consider what role gratitude has in your giving.

## **Group Opener**

Are you naturally a person who prefers to spend money or someone who prefers to save money?

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. We read that Jesus asked people to invest wealth into the kingdom. Does that feel like a habit that Christians used to do, or still do?
- Discuss the quote from missionary Kosuke Koyama.
  "Man is supposed to eat bread. But what if bread eats man? What if income is using man instead of man using income?"
- 3. Read Matt 6:19-21

Jesus teaches that loyalties can feel twisted or split. Finances still create tension in our lives. Talk through a time in your life when finances created a tension that might have split your loyalties to your family time, or maybe even your spiritual walk?

- 4. Christians can either feel a lot of guilt about this message or feel very little conviction about giving. How can this passage from Jesus be an encouragement to grow with Him more?
- 5. How has giving & gratitude shaped your spiritual life?
