2. Read 1 Kings 18:16-21. What was the problem and the challenge facing the people of Israel?
3. As you think about following God with a full commitment of your time, talents, and treasures, what are some of the competing “gods” that tempt you to give some of your energy to?
4. Read 1 Kings 18:30-39.
Elijah had to rebuild the neglected altar before God would show up by his demonstration of fire on Mt. Carmel. Are there any areas of your life where the altar of your heart for God has become neglected and needs to be rebuilt?
