## Own The Fight 2 Timothy 2:1-13

A life of purpose relies on <u>God's grace</u> to be strong and <u>passes on</u> truth to others who will faithfully <u>pass on</u> truth (1-2).
A life of purpose knows the <u>cost</u> and is willing to take the <u>risk</u> (3-7).
A life of purpose is <u>motivated</u> by the gospel and is <u>willing</u> to endure <u>everything</u> for some to be saved (8-13).
Own the Truth:  A life of purpose chooses to <u>endure</u> , motivated and strengthened by the

gospel, so that others may be saved.
