

Jesus Offers Forgiveness – Luke 5 Feb 16, 2025

Scripture: Luke 5:17-26

Sermon Points:

This is the beginning of Jesus fulfilling who He said He would reach in Luke 4 "poor...captive...blind...oppressed"

James 2:18 But someone will say, "You have faith and I have works." Show me your faith apart from your works, and I will show you my faith by my works.

Can Jesus really forgive? Would Jesus really forgive?

Jesus has <u>ability</u> (vs 17) and <u>authority</u> (vs 24) to forgive. But does He have <u>patience</u>?

Jesus has the patience, intent, desire, ability, and authority to forgive.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Is it easier for you to forgive someone or ask for forgiveness?
- 2. READ Luke 5:17-20 What do you think the obstacles (crowd, the roof, etc.) symbolize in this story? How can we as a small group help overcome obstacles when we encounter challenges in following Christ?
- 3. Discuss the friends of the paralytic, What does the determination to bring the man to Jesus say about the importance of community in faith?
- 4. Is it a regular part of your prayer time to ask Jesus for forgiveness? What does this look/sound like?
- 5. In your parenting, or marriage, or other core relationships, do you value or avoid the practice of confrontation and/or apologizing?
- 6. How enduring do you believe Jesus' forgiveness runs? Does your belief about His forgiveness need to win over any doubt your heart would have?
