Sermon Main Points:

Thriving is not a human achievement, but a divine enablement

1. God's Spirit helps me draw from God's power

3. God's Spirit helps me walk in God's truth
4. God's Spirit helps me receive God's peace

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. God has made no provision for you alone to live the Christian life, but only for Him to live it through you. List a few ways how the Holy Spirit has helped you grow closer to Jesus?
2. Is there an area in your life where you need God's power to change? It could be a mindset, a habit, or a relationship. What does it look like for you to try to control that area on your own? What might it look like to surrender control of that to God?
3. What step of obedience might God want you to take next? Have you stepped out to share the love of Jesus with someone near you lately? Why or why not? What is your greatest barrier to doing so?
4. Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to empower us to join Him in His mission of helping others find their way home to the Father. Spend time praying for each other in your group, that God would give you opportunities to share the love of Jesus with someone this week.
