Ephesians 1:18-20

The intention of God is to provide His power to your person

Joseph -> into slavery -> into jail -> into throne room

-> preserves God's promise to Abraham

David -> into a fight -> into persecution -> in caves -> into throne room

-> preserves God's promise to Abraham

1. You're anchored to something eternal
2. Demonstrates dependable character more than power
