MY APPLICATION

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- 4. Have you ever been in a broken relationship that you had no power to reconcile? How does this make God's efforts to reconcile you to him more precious?
