

**The Future Body** 

Our present bodies are wearing down; however, our future bodies will be glorious. And our future body point to the fullness of our redemption and is meant to spur our present action. As a result, is there a labor God is calling you to?

**Scripture:** 1 Corinthians 15:35-58 - "Although our present bodies are wearing down, our future bodies will be glorious and eternal."

## Sermon Points:

- 1. The future body will be glorious. (v35-44a)
- 2. The future body points to the fullness of our redemption. (v45-57)
- 3. The future body is meant to spur our <u>present action</u>. (v58)

**Group Opener:** Growing up, we use to hear many different ideas about what heaven would be like. What are some of the more interesting ideas of heaven you've heard?

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. Read 1 Corinthians 15:35-44. What stands out to you from this passage? As you read through the contrast between our present body and our future body, what are you most looking forward to?
- 2. Read 1 Corinthians 15:58. From the passage, can you articulate in your own words why our "labor in the Lord is not in vain?" What is your current "labor in the Lord?"
- 3. As a result of the message, is there a labor God is calling you to engage in? Pray for one another to labor in the ways God is leading us to or are already engaged in.
