Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect." Romans 12: 1-2 (ESV)

III. FOUR QUALITIES OF GREATNESS

1. A **Humble** Heart.

A reverence for God and respect for others.

2. A **Grateful** Heart.

An appreciation for what they have been given and Who has given it to them.

3. A **Generous** Heart.

Taking great delight in sharing with others what God has entrusted to you.

"Give, and it will be given to you. Good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap. For with the measure you use it will be measured back to you." Luke 6:38 (ESV)

4. **Servant's** Heart.

Willingness to take action in order to help someone else.
