



‘Why do you look for the living among the dead?’ **Apr 20, 2025**

NOTE: Happy Easter! With 3 different churches and a live speaker at each location we know each message will be a unique. What is in common is the scripture Luke 24:1-12. Therefore this weeks discussions questions are focused on the service and the text.

Scripture: *Luke 24:1-12*

But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they went to the tomb, taking the spices they had prepared. ²And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, ³but when they went in they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. ⁴While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel.

⁵And as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, “Why do you seek the living among the dead? ⁶He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, ⁷that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise.”

Discussion Questions:

1. When you think of Easter services what “stuck with you” and how does that encourage your own response to Jesus?
2. We saw over 150 people follow Jesus by being baptized in water. How did the Easter baptisms effect you?
3. Read and discuss Luke 24:1-7
4. The angel asked, “Why do you seek the living among the dead?” How does that question speak to where we look for hope, or purpose today?
