MY APPLICATION

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

1. Read Ezekiel 37:1-10. Why is the valley full of bones and who do the bones represent? Have you ever wondered how God can be good and still judge people for their sins?
2. Have you ever wondered if you or someone you know is irredeemable? What makes it hard to believe that God would save even the worst sinner? Do you have someone in your life that you feel is “too far gone?” Have your group pray for them.
3. When you think of your life before becoming a follower of Jesus, did you consider yourself dead and under a curse? Read Ephesians 2:1-4. Why is it important to know what you have been saved from to experience the joy of your salvation?
4. What are you most grateful for this Thanksgiving? How will you express and celebrate your gratitude?
