**REVIEW:**

**God's Design**

The intensity of man's drive for sexual intimacy with a woman reflects the intensity of God's desire for spiritual intimacy with man.

God designed human sexuality as a picture of the complete connection He would desire in His relationship with His people.

**Man's Depravity**

Disconnection from the spiritual satisfaction found in a relationship with God, we hunger for satisfaction and try to find our fulfillment in sensual pursuits.

**Sensual Satisfaction:**

Our Drive For Pleasure Replaces Our Passion For Spiritual Intimacy.

**Sexual Conquest:**

Our Drive For Personal Affirmation Replaces Our Passion For Personal Connections.

Appropriate sexual behavior is a complete emotional, physical, and spiritual connection between a husband and wife resulting in the by-products of pleasure, intimacy, and perpetuation of the family.

Inappropriate sexual behavior is anything else.

Sexual obsession ranges from sexually revolted to sexually repelled to sexually engrossed to sexually obsessed.
