Scripture Text: Jonah 4

Is there an area of your life that is poisoned by anger? If so, what would it mean to surrender that anger to God? Since God's heart toward people is often very different from ours, we can actually transform our way of thinking when we conform our heart toward His.

## **Sermon Points:**

<u>The Big Idea:</u> When we understand God's heart, He invites us to conform our hearts to His

- 1. An entitled heart warps our view of people.
- 2. A self-righteous heart warps our view of God.

- Re-read Jonah 4. Describe a time God didn't support your idea of what is right. Did you feel angry?
