MY APPLICATION

1. Talk about your prayer life. When do you pray, where, and what does that time tend to look like? Have you picked a place and time yet?
2. Read 5:13-15. Share about a time when you prayed for something, and it happened. Share about something you prayed for, but it didn't happen. What did you learn through that experience?
3. Do you believe that prayer impacts your life tangibly? Why or why not? Do you ever struggle to believe that?
4. Read 5:15-16. Do you confess your sins to God regularly? Why or why not? If you do, how do you tend to do it?
5. Do you confess your sins to someone else regularly? If you don't, is there someone in your life who you could confess to? Consider this week starting, or restarting that practice, first with God and then with someone else.
