Sermon Points:

The beginning of a forever plan to share the work with us. Ephesians 4:8, 11-12 We pray for people that will go -Leander -Steiner Ranch -Indian Bible Church -Refugees in Austin -Unreached in Northern Africa God provides before and as we follow. It won't work every time and that's OK. Remember what the fight is.

Small Group Opener Question:

What are some of the "rumors" or misconceptions people have about Christianity today?

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What emotions or feelings do you think the 72 disciples might have experienced when Jesus sent them out?
- 2. Read Luke 10:1-2 Jesus instructs them to pray for laborers. What does this show us about the nature of God's work?

NOTE: At some point during your small group we should do what Jesus asks us to pray for workers in the harvest. Then lead your group to play their role.

- 3. **"They didn't go off to bible college for four years..."** How does it make you feel that Jesus sent out disciples who were still learning and growing? Does this change your perspective on who God can use?
- 4. What are some potential "harvests" that you see around you?
- 5. Have you ever felt unprepared for a task God called you to? How did you respond, and what did you learn?
- 6. What is one practical step you can take this week to be more intentional about sharing your faith or serving in your church or community?
