Small Group Opener Question:

What are some of the "rumors" or misconceptions people have about Christianity today?

Discussion Questions:

1. What emotions or feelings do you think the 72 disciples might have experienced when Jesus sent them out?
2. Read Luke 10:1-2 - Jesus instructs them to pray for laborers. What does this show us about the nature of God's work?

NOTE: At some point during your small group we should do what Jesus asks us to pray for workers in the harvest. Then lead your group to play their role.

3. **"They didn't go off to bible college for four years..."** How does it make you feel that Jesus sent out disciples who were still learning and growing? Does this change your perspective on who God can use?
4. What are some potential "harvests" that you see around you?
5. Have you ever felt unprepared for a task God called you to? How did you respond, and what did you learn?
6. What is one practical step you can take this week to be more intentional about sharing your faith or serving in your church or community?
