- 3. Read Ezra 1:5-11. What strikes you most about how God is working in these groups of people: the Jews, the Jews' neighbors, and Cyrus? How is God working in you? Are you accountable to that?
- 4. Read Ezra 2:1-11. Did you realize that God keeps lists of people who respond to his invitation to join His work? How does that encourage you to be on that list? How does that give you hope pressing into 2023?
- 5. Did you take some time since hearing the message to hear from God on what He is inviting you to do in this new year?
