Scripture Text: Ephesians 5

Sermon Points:

- 3. Jesus is the motivation in a Christian marriage
- 4. Christ is the model for the husband
- 5. The church is the model for the wife

Discussion Question Options:

- What was particularly impactful about this week's message on marriage?
- What kind of family did you grow up in? e.g blended, stable, etc. What other factors (media, etc.) informed or influenced your model of marriage?
- We see God inspiring Paul to explain Christian marriage by starting with Ephesians 5:21 "Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ." How does this steer the subsequent guidance for men and women within marriage?
- What do we learn from the <u>relationship</u> and the <u>roles</u> that God gives husbands and wives in light of the relationship between Jesus and the church? What action steps might this lead you to this week?
- As we process the impact marriages we've experienced in the past + our
 present experience with marriage relationships, pray for one another to rely on
 God's grace and forgiveness as we follow the example of Jesus.
