MY APPLICATION

1. Think about one or two of the difference makers in your life. Share with the group one example of how they made a difference in a specific way.
2. Why did Jesus give us baptism as a picture of what he did for us and who we are to be? (See Matthew 28:18-20, Romans 6:2-4) Describe your baptism and the meaning it had for you at the time and now.
3. Read the story of Dorcas in Acts 9:36-43. What stands out to you in the story? Describe what you think your life would be like today if you never came to know and put your faith in Jesus.
4. Do you feel like you are a difference maker? What would you like to get out of this study to help you grow to become one?
