MY APPLICATION

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

1. Each of us lives out of some type of story. What influences most shaped the story you have been living?
2. At His resurrection, Jesus defeated all that defeats us: sin, shame, even death. In what ways does the Risen Christ give you hope in your daily life (see 1 Peter 1:3-10)?
3. Every person in John 20 was changed by God's grace in Jesus. In what ways has Jesus changed you? How has He changed your sense of identity? How has God's family helped you grow in Jesus?
4. Jesus commissioned all of His followers to continue and complete His mission in the world. How have you been sharing the hope of Jesus with others? Think of someone you know who may be far from God. Take a moment and pray for God to draw them to Jesus. Text or invite them to one of our upcoming Easter weekend services.
