The God Who Calls: Ezekiel 2-3

Sermon Description

When you think of a life calling, what comes to mind? God is one who calls people for a life mission to be a difference maker. If you don't feel like you've heard God's call on your life, pray for Him to clear any obstacles and to open your heart.

Sermon Points:

- 1. The Prophet: The call to <u>share</u> God's truth with others
- 2. The Watchman: The call to warn people about the coming judgement
- 3. The Gap Filler: The call to be the difference maker

Group Opener: Share a time when you felt compelled to make a big change in your life or your family's lives. Did/has God shown you anything through those seasons?

Discussion Questions:

- 1. When you think of a life calling, what comes to mind? Do you believe that God has a life calling that he gives to everyone? See Ephesians 2:10.
- 2. Does it seem to you that Ezekiel was called or conscripted/recruited (Ezekiel 2:1-8 and 3:12-15)? Why would God totally overwhelm Ezekiel to get him to be his prophet?
- 3. What is the role of the Watchman? Do you feel any responsibility for the souls of the people around you? Why or why not? See Ezekiel 3:16-19.
- 4. The God who calls is looking for difference makers. What might this mean for you? What will be your impact on this earth? Pray for God to clear obstacles and open heart in your group.
