Memory Verse John 15:5

2. When we step out of fellowship with God, we are not useful for His eternal purpose. What does this look like in our lives as believers in Jesus?(See John 15:2, 6). How does this future meeting with Jesus change the way you live today?
3. What does it mean to "remain" in Jesus? (See John 15:4-5, 9-10) How is Jesus' relationship with the Father helpful to understanding the concept of "remain in my love." (See John 4:34; 5:19-20) What is the connection between commands, obey, and love?
4. What fruit is God currently producing in your life?
