Welcome, Ladies!

We are so happy that you have chosen to join us on our *Journey through the Story of God!* In this final semester we will be sprinting toward the finish line, enjoying a grand overview of the New Testament. This is a marvelous opportunity for us to see how God's grace has provided the way for us to know God as Savior and to enjoy Him as a Father who loves us dearly.

In our study this semester, we're going to see the life of Christ from four different perspectives as we study the four gospels in the New Testament. We're going to see how God has built, expanded, and shaped His community of faith—the church universal. We're going to see how God has provided for our personal growth in godliness. We're going to see how God is *transforming* us—shaping us into the people He created us to be. We will learn about the good news of our salvation, about wisdom for living, about the privilege of a relationship with God, and about the glory of our ultimate future.

- Read the selected passages from the Bible
- Complete each week's study questions
- Come each week to share your insights with others in your group and watch the lecture

This coming week, as your preparation for Week Two, you should read and complete the study questions for *Week Two: The Gospel of Matthew*.
