



## Week Two Discussion Questions

1. What's your favorite piece of fan-wear? What does it represent? Why do you like to wear it?
2. The Apostle Paul described the identifiers of those who follow Jesus in Colossians 3:12. Talk about a time when you've experienced one of these qualities in someone else recently.
3. How much have you considered the idea lately that we are not required to change in order to be accepted by God? What do you think of the idea that we change as a result of being loved by God, rather than working for His love?
4. Talk about a time when you've experienced someone's compassion—moving toward you to feel your pain with you. How does that experience shape your view of God?
5. Reed described the attribute of gentleness as adjusting our approach for the sake of someone else. How would our world change if we all used more gentleness in our relationships?
6. What's at stake if we don't put on our "kingdom clothes?" What's at stake in your life? What's at stake in others' lives?

This week, consider asking someone close to you to tell you what items of "kingdom wear" they see you've put on, and which ones you may still need to wear more often.
