

1. Where have you felt the nudge to be bold, but fear held you back?

Acts 3:6 – "Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk."

- Peter didn't let what he lacked (money, prestige) stop him from offering what he *did* have Jesus.
- **Follow-up:** Can you think of a time where you *did* respond to that nudge? What happened?

2. How have you seen boldness in someone else draw people closer to Jesus?

Acts 4:4 – "But many who heard the message believed..."

- Boldness in action often precedes belief in others.
- Follow-up: Can you share a story of someone else's courage or conviction that impacted your own faith?

3. What would change in your life if you consistently prayed for boldness?

Acts 4:29-31 – "Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness..."

- The early church didn't pray for safety, they prayed for *more boldness*! Even after already being bold.
- Follow-up: What scares you about praying that prayer? And what excites you?
