Discussion Questions

1. Jonah obeyed God's command but didn't share God's heart. What does this teach us about the difference between outward obedience and inward transformation?
2. Jonah was angry that God showed grace to people he thought didn't deserve it. Can you think of a time when you struggled to extend grace to someone? What made it difficult?
3. The message called out the "grace double standard" — wanting grace for ourselves but justice for others. In what areas of your life are you most tempted to live with this double standard?
4. God asked Jonah, "Is it right for you to be angry?" How might that same question challenge us when we're upset about how God treats others with mercy?
5. The story ends unresolved, leaving us to wrestle with our own response. If God's heart is gracious, compassionate, slow to anger, and abounding in love — how can we better reflect that heart this week in our relationships?
