3. Have you visited a part of the world where Christianization is less evident or not evident at all? If so, what differences did you notice?
4. Read **John 13:34–35** aloud.

“A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”

What does Jesus’s command to love “as I have loved you” reveal about the kind of community the church was meant to be?

5. What’s one habit or rhythm you could add—or return to—that would allow the church’s teaching and relationships to shape you more consistently?
