- 4. Read John 8:10. This woman is beyond the shadow of a doubt guilty, and she deserves punishment and condemnation. But how does Jesus reveal the character of God in his response to her? How do compassion and

- forgiveness replacing shame and condemnation change our responses to God and others?
- 5. How does Jesus end his encounter with the adulterous woman in John 8:11? The mercy of God always meets us where we are, but it never leaves us there. Share an example of God's faithfulness, goodness, or mercy in your life.
