- 4. What can we learn from Jesus washing Judas's feet... even though he knew Judas would betray him?
- 5. What are some of the obstacles you face when it comes to 'washing one another's feet'?
- 6. In your own words, describe what it means to *live low*. What is one specific way you can *live low* this week?
