Discussion Questions:

- 1. Share a positive time you experienced deep community (e.g., sports team, family, church, etc.).
- 2. In the message, Zach talked about a family that was instrumental in making the church seem like family. Do you have experience where someone took you under their wing and made the church feel like home? If so, who? What did they do that made you feel that way?
- 3. Read Acts 2:42–47 aloud. Notice some of the regular practices of the early church:

 What are the upsides—and risks—when a community lives like that?
- 4. What would it look like for our church to truly be a family? What can you do about it?
