Discussion Questions

- 1. On a scale of 1 to 10, how good are you at remembering things? Is it the big things or the small things (or both) you sometimes forget?
- 2. In what ways do you think forgetfulness can be an enemy to our faith?
- 3. Read Joshua 4:1–7. What is a "stone" of remembrance in your faith that you can look back to as a time of God's faithfulness?
- 4. What are we remembering when we take Communion, and why do you think it's important for us to keep this before us as we seek to follow Jesus?
- 5. Read 1 Corinthians 11:28. Not one of us is perfect or deserving of Jesus's sacrifice, so why do you think Paul instructs us to "examine" ourselves before taking Communion?
- 6. How can the meaning of Communion practically impact our faith?
