- 4. Read **Nehemiah 6:3:** *I am doing a great work and I cannot come down.*What do you think it means for our church to "stay on the wall" today?
- 5. As you think about North Point's 30-year story, what stands out to you about the kind of impact it's had on you personally?
- 6. As North Point looks to the next 30 years, what kind of church do you hope we continue to be known for?
