## Pathway to Prosperity

### Discussion Questions:

1. When you think of someone who is truly generous, what qualities stand out about their life?
2. How does Proverbs 11:25 and the story of Cain and Abel redefine generosity compared to how our culture normally understands it?
3. Read **Luke 12:15** aloud.  
*Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; life does not consist in an abundance of possessions."*  
In your own words, what was Jesus warning against?
4. Why is money often the area where generosity is hardest to practice?
5. Which of the three elements of true generosity—giving from gratitude, giving with priority (first and best), or giving to the right target—is most challenging for you personally, and why?
6. If generosity really is an "inflection point," what specific change in how you handle your time, money, or priorities could shift the direction of your life toward greater trust in God this season?
