3. What comes to mind when you hear the word "evangelism"? Does it feel uncomfortable? Scary? Exciting?

5. Read John 20:21 and John 3:16. Reed described "how" the Father sent Jesus in love, not condemnation. What would it look like for you to share Jesus with someone, motivated by love? What's at stake if we choose not to share?

When love is our motivation, it outweighs any fear we have of the outcome. Remember, God gave us the Holy Spirit. When we share the gospel with someone, he is with us to empower and equip us.
